**Christ the King.**

## **SAINTS OF THE WEEK:**

**23<sup>rd</sup> November: St Clement (c.96) Pope and Martyr** The third Bishop of Rome after St Peter. Author of a letter to the Church in Corinth which had asked him to arbitrate in a dispute. His life and letter afford valuable evidence for the state of the Church in Rome and the development of the ministry. His Church in Rome is remarkable in that it stands over three levels of excavations. **St Columban (c.543-615)** Irish Abbot and missionary who founded monasteries in France, Germany, Switzerland and Italy. He and his monks had a great influence on the development of Christianity and the establishment of learning in those areas.
