**SAINTS OF THE WEEK: 19<sup>th</sup> May - St Dunstan (c.909-988)** He became a Monk at Glastonbury and eventually its Abbot. He was a strict ascetic who over his lifetime revived the declining monasteries of his day which often also became centres of learning, art etc. He combined this work with a life in politics advising various Kings and becoming very influential. He used this influence to reform and restore the Church in England. Patron of Goldsmiths. The tradition of placing a horseshoe over a door for protection is said to derive from a legend about a fight Dunstan had with the devil involving a horseshoe!
