SAINTS OF THE WEEK: Thursday: St John Mary Vianney (The Curé of Ars) 1786-1859 Born near Lyon, he showed an early desire to become a priest. His studies were however interrupted by his conscription into the army, from which he deserted. His ordination was also delayed by his inability to learn Latin. Finally ordained in 1815 he spent three years as an assistant priest and was then made Curé of the remote village of Ars, where he remained for the rest of his life. A somewhat austere man he became very widely known for his skills as a counsellor and in the confessional. By 1855 the numbers of visitors he received from all over the world was estimated at 20,000 a year and he sometimes spent up to 18 hours a day in the confessional. He is the Patron of Parish Priests.
