SAINTS OF THE WEEK: 21st February: St Peter Damian (c.1007-1072) Born into a very poor family Peter spent his boyhood tending pigs until his talent was noticed and he was sent to the Benedictine Monastery at Fonte Avella to be educated. Eventually he became a monk. He was a man of great austerity and became noteworthy for his reforming zeal. First in monasteries and then in the Church at large. He was sent by various Popes on diplomatic missions and made a Cardinal. He was also well known as a theologian.

CHURCH CLEAN FOR EASTER: Tuesday 28th March after Mass, any help is much appreciated.

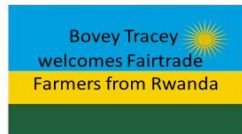
CHRISM MASS: Wednesday 5th April, at 12noon at Plymouth Cathedral, for the celebration of the annual Chrism Mass. At this Mass the Bishop blesses the Holy Oils to be used in every parish in the coming year and priests renews their commitment. The presider will be the newly ordained (by then) Auxiliary of Southwark, Bishop (presently Elect) Philip Moger. He has graciously accepted to celebrate his first Chrism Mass with us, and we would ask you to keep him in your prayers, particularly on the day of his Episcopal Ordination on 21st February.

GOOD FRIDAY: There will be a collection at the end of Mass to contribute to the Holy See collection for the Holy Places of the Holy Land.

For your sakes Christ became poor (cf. 2 Cor 8:9) In his message for World Day of the Poor 2022, Pope Francis reminded us of the meaning of solidarity: 'sharing the little we have with those who have nothing, so that no one will go without'. Lent is a time of prayer, fasting and almsgiving in preparation for the resurrection of the Lord at Easter.
