**SAINTS OF THE WEEK: Monday 20<sup>th</sup> March: St Joseph** He was betrothed to Mary when she conceived Christ by the Holy Spirit. At first he was intending to repudiate Mary, but inspired by the Holy Spirit he married her and so became the foster father of Jesus. Jesus worked alongside him until he began his ministry at the age of thirty. Joseph was a man clearly devoted to his family and ready to pay a high price for that dedication leaving his homeland to go to Egypt as a refugee to escape Herod's attempt to kill the infant Jesus. Eventually when it was safe to do so he returned with his family and settled in Nazareth where he worked as a carpenter (probably a small builder). No mention of him is made of in the Gospels after this and it is thought that he was an older man who, therefore died long before Mary. Patron of the Universal church, Canada, carpenters and manual workers.

**23<sup>rd</sup> March: St Turibius of Mogrovejo (1538-1606)** Born at Valladolid in Spain of a noble family and highly educated. He became Professor of law at Salamanca University. Ordained Priest in 1578, he was sent to Peru and made Archbishop of Lima. A tireless worker he spent his time traversing his territory on foot sometimes in conditions of great hardship and danger. He is said to have baptised and confirmed over half a million souls including St Rose of Lima and St Martin de Porres. Patron of Lima and Latin American Bishops.
