SAINTS OF THE WEEK: 24th April: St George (d303) Very little is known about his life or even his martyrdom. Very probably he was martyred about 303 at Lydda (in modern Israel). The story of the dragon is probably a confusion with the ancient legend of Perseus' slaying of a sea monster in that area. Although now the Patron of England this is a relatively recent title (14th Century) due to his being made Patron of the Order of the Garter.

Day of Prayer for Victims and Survivors of Abuse 30th April 2024: The Bishop's of England and Wales have set aside the Tuesday of the Fifth Week of Easter as a Day of Prayer for Victims and Survivors of Abuse. This year's focus is on communities who have been directly affected by allegations or convictions related to abuse-especially, but not exclusively, within the Church.
